Graham Avery was born in Wales in 1943, he was educated at Kingswood School, Bath and at Balliol College, Oxford University, where he obtained the degree of Master of Arts in Literae Humaniores (classical studies and philosophy). At Harvard University he was a Fellow of the Center for International Affairs. He was a Practitioner Fellow of the Sussex European Institute in 2002-2003, and on his return to the Commission he acted as principal adviser in the Enlargement Directorate-General and is currently, chief adviser, Planning and Economic Analysis, Directorate-General for External Relations.;He began his career in the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food in London, where he held posts as Principal responsible for the British negotiations for membership of the European Communities, and as Private Secretary to successive Ministers (Fred Peart, John Silkin).;Mr. Avery joined the European Commission in Brussels in 1973 when the UK entered the EC, as a member of the Cabinet of Christopher Soames, Vice-President responsible for external relations. He was adviser and then Deputy Head of Cabinet of Roy Jenkins, President of the Commission in 1977-80. He held posts in the Directorate General for Agriculture as Head of Division for Economic questions, and as Director for rural development, and was a member of the cabinets of several Commissioners responsible for agriculture (Finn Gundelach, Poul Dalsager, Frans Andriessen).;In the Directorate General for External Relations, Mr. Avery was Director for relations with the USA, Canada, Australia and New Zealand, and Director for relations with the countries of the European Free Trade Area and the European Economic Area. As Director in the Task Force for Enlargement he participated in the accession negotiations with Austria, Sweden, Finland and Norway in 1993-94, and was the Commission's principal negotiator with Austria. He was Chief Adviser for Foreign Policy Planning in 1995; Chief Adviser for Enlargement in 1996-98, responsible for the opinions on the applications for membership by countries of Central and Eastern Europe; and Chief Adviser for strategic questions in the Directorate General for Enlargement in 2000-02. He contributed to the Commission's "Agenda 2000" report, and was author of "Policies for an Enlarged Union" for the Commission's White Paper on Governance in 2001.;In 1998-2000 as Inspector General of the Commission he was head of the Inspection Générale des Services (IGS) where he conducted management audits, co-ordinated the report "Designing Tomorrow's Commission", and contributed to the White Paper on Administrative Reform.;Mr Avery has published articles in magazines and journals including, Prospect, European Affairs, International Affairs, World Today, Oxford International Review, European Environment Review, and the Journal of Agricultural Economies. He is co-author of the book, "The Enlargement of the European Union", published in 1998. At the time of writing, Avery was a practitioner Fellow at the Robert Schuman Centre of the European University Institute, Florence.

In presenting to the European Parliament the Commission's intention to publish a White Paper on European Governance, President Prodi underlined the need for reflection on the enlarged Union's policies. The work programme for the White Paper, as approved by the Commission, provided for an interservice group to undertake the task of "preparing the organisation of a debate" at European level, including the applicant countries. The basic idea was to ensure, with the continental unification of Europe, the solidarity necessary for reconstruction by mobilising the historical, geographical and cultural inheritance which has helped to promote the growth of economic and trade relations throughout Europe. The mandate of the Group was to draw up a "discussion framework" for the Union, its member states and the applicant countries, in such a way as to define in more detail the conditions for optimising the contribution of its policies to the needs of the enlarged Union on a 10-15 year perspective, and should cover all of the Union's policies, existing or foreseen by the Treaties. The group dealt with human resources, competitiveness and cohesion, diversity of Europe's territory, proximity policy. The group was presided over by Graham Avery and included members from various DG's. The group organised external auditions and drew up a list of correspondents interested in the future of Europe, from among researchers and practitioners in EU countries and applicant countries, the group was established in late 2000 and produced its findings in a White Paper on European Governance, "Policies for an Enlarged Union" and was adopted by the Commission on the 25 July 2001.

GJLA.IGS Inspectorate General of Services

The Inspectorate general (IGS - Inspection Générale des Services) exists to promote efficiency, effectiveness and economy in the functioning of the Commission's services. For this purpose, it provides the Commission with analyses and recommendations concerning: the organisation and use of resources (human, material, financial) employed by the services, the relationship between the resources used and the results obtained, the respect of the priorities decided by the Commission, the respect of appropriate procedures, working methods and rules.

Reporting to the Vice-President for Administrative Reform, it executes its task in independence, under the direction of the Inspector General, head of the service. It makes recommendations and gives advice independently of, but in co-operation with, the services concerned. Its task of organisational audit is distinct from that of the Commission's financial audit. Its inspections, audits and reports may concern a single service - "vertical" reports - or subjects involving several or all services - "horizontal" reports. It monitored the implementation of its recommendations by the services concerned

however it was not responsible for tasks of management or execution. It gave priority in its activities to questions related to the Commission's programme of administrative reform. It contributed to the development of measures of administrative reform and the monitoring of their application.

The IGS performs its work on the basis of a mandate, endorsed by the Vice-President after consultation with the relevant members of the Commission and Heads of Services. Each report is made by a team of inspectors working in collaboration with the service concerned, with full freedom of movement and their investigation, and access to whatever information may be required for the accomplishment of their task. Their report is presented to the Head of Service for comments, which are included in the final report.

The DECODE screening exercise was launched by the Santer Commission and proved a useful tool in providing basic information for the allocation of portfolios and reorganisation of the Commission's services by President Prodi, as well as providing essential basic data for the administrative reform process.


The fact that the screening exercise was carried out not only by the central services but with the active participation of the operational DGs (some 80 officials were mobilised for this exercise and interviews took place with all of the management of the Commission from Director-General down to Head of Unit) was valuable in itself in that it gave the officials throughout the Commission a sense of involvement in and ownership of the exercise. As a result an exhaustive inventory of the work carried out by the Commission services was produced along with a photograph of the way in which its human resources (statutory and non-statutory) were allocated to this work (by activity and by task) and an overview of the working methods used by the services of the Commission. The data collected was stored in a DECODE database.

Whilst the first objective of the screening exercise was simply to take a photograph of the situation at that particular time, the resulting reports were of value not only for the descriptive elements but also for the analysis and for the resulting conclusions and recommendations. A large number of these recommendations found themselves in the draft White Paper on Administrative Reform.

The DECODE report covered a diverse range of themes, such as: Best Practices, Duplication of Effort, Performance Indicators, Multisite Questions.

The 47 DECODE reports on individual DGs were distributed to the Directors General concerned and put on the Commission's "intranet" by the end of 1998, so they were effectively available to all Commission personnel, but not to the public. Subsequently in January 2000 a synthesis of the responses of Directors General to these reports, and the action taken, was distributed internally. The 12 Group Reports, were of a more sensitive nature, containing recommendations for future organisation, and were not distributed in their complete form even to the Directors General concerned: a summary of them was later distributed. The final DECODE report was made available to all personnel of the Commission, transmitted to the European Parliament and published on the Commission's website in 1999 (but by 2003 it had been removed).

The Inspectorate General (IGS - Inspection Générale des Services) existed to promote efficiency, effectiveness and economy in the functioning of the Commission's services. For this purpose it provided the Commission with analyses and recommendations concerning: the organisation and use of resources (human, material, financial) employed by the services, the relationship between the resources used and the results obtained, the respect of the priorities decided by the Commission, the respect of appropriate procedures, working methods and rules.

The IGS performed its work on the basis of a mandate, endorsed by the Vice-President after consultation with the relevant members of the Commission and Heads of Services. Its reports are sent to the Vice-President, to the President and Secretary General of the Commission. Each report was made by a team of inspectors working in collaboration with the service concerned, with full freedom of movement and investigation.

The work of IGS was conducted by methods designed to ensure high standards of objective analysis. The methodology is based on best practice prevailing in the field of organisational audit, and was subject to regular revision. The results of its work was evaluated with the aid of the services audited. Its work programme, working practices and organisation were determined in accordance with the Commission's decision of 1991 concerning the creation of IGS.


A number of specific reports on "thematic" issues were made by the IGS during the DECODE exercise, on human resources, organisation etc. Later further reports were

made by Neil Kinnock, and circulated within the Commission, on themes such as Excellence in Public Administration, and Good Practices in the Commission's Services. These files also give the background to Prodi's decisions with regard to the "first steps" in the reform of the Commission, which were later confirmed by the Commission when it formally took office in September 1999.

These files also concern the work of the IGS from its inception to its abolition, in particular the series of Activity Reports presented to the Commission, and also the DECODE report on the IGS itself.
